The Minister of Transportation issued the following amendment, which was published in Kovetz Hatakkatot 5071, at pages 263-264 (17 December 1987), Aircraft Regulations (Operation of Aircraft and Rules of Flight), 1987.

6. After Regulation 11 of the principle regulations shall come -

In this regulation -

"Smoking" - the smoking of a cigarette, cigarillo, cigar or pipe or the holding of them when lit.

"Israeli Aircraft" - as defined in the Air Navigation (Offences and Jurisdiction) Law -1971,;

("Israel Aircraft means (1) an aircraft registered in the Registry of Aircraft in Israel;(2) an aircraft not registered as aforesaid if more than half of it is owned by the State of Israel, an Israeli national, a resident of Israel or an Israeli body corporate;(3) an aircraft chartered by the State of Israel, an Israeli national, a resident of Israel or an Israeli body corporate." )

(b) A person shall not smoke in an Israeli aircraft (henceforth in this regulation - aircraft).

(c) Notwithstanding that which is set forth in sub-section (b), a person may smoke cigarettes in an aircraft -

- (1) on a commercial flight which continues for more than two hours from the point of departure to its final destination, provided that the smoker is located in an area and seat specified for that purpose by the operator and after the no-smoking sign has been turned-off;
- (2) on a non-commercial flight;
- (3) on a charter flight for personal use as defined in the Registration of Airport Services (Charter Flights) Regulations - 1982.
- (4) on a flight in which the Director approved smoking.

(d) In addition to that which is set forth in sub-section (c), no person shall smoke in an aircraft when

- (1) the no-smoking signs are illuminated;
- (2) in the restrooms of the aircraft;
- (3) in the aisles, between the passenger seats;
- (4) alongside the doors of the aircraft;
- (5) a member of the crew forbids smoking.

(e) The operator will fix in each aircraft in which smoking is prohibited illuminated signs, which shall be in good condition at all times, setting forth the prohibition of smoking in the amount, size and shape as shall be determined by the Director (Chief of the Civil Aeronautic Authority in the Ministry of Transportation).
